Subject: Playing while under suspension

Effective Date: September 1, 2004

Date of Last Revision: None

Any player who is suspended by any USSF affiliated entity and is found to have played, or attempted to play in any OASA game, shall be suspended for a minimum of one-year, in addition to the previous suspension.

What this means is that if a player gets a red card, and has a duplicate card and attempts to play using it, or attempts to use a player card other than their own to play in a game while under suspension they will be suspended for at least one additional year. The team, player and manager may be subject to additional sanctions such as forfeiture of the game(s), fines, and/or additional suspensions.
