OASA is seeking committee members for a committee which will meet one time. Leagues are encouraged to pass this along to any person who may be interested. Interested people should contact the OASA office to express their interest.

Additionally, nominations are now open – any affiliated league may nominate as many referees as they wish for each of two separate honors.

- 1. Nomination to be sent to a regional or National event**
- 2. Nomination as Oregon Adult Referee of the Year.**

Referee Recognition Committee Job Description and Expectations

Purpose: To review nominations for referee recognition from affiliated leagues and make recommendations to OASA's Board of Directors.

Major responsibilities:

- Review nominations
- Participate in discussion regarding the suitability of candidates
- Recommend candidates for recognition.

Meetings and time commitment:

The committee will meet one time per year, recommendations must be made prior to March 1, so it is anticipated that the committee will meet in Mid-February, members will receive nominations electronically prior to meeting and are asked to review them prior to the meeting. Meeting expected to last less than two hours on an evening.

Expectations of committee members:

- Should not be involved in any aspect of referee assignment.
- Should not be an active referee.
- Should be fair and impartial.
- Should be interested in furthering the mission of OASA.

Nominations for OASA Referee Recognition. Any affiliated league may nominate as many referees as they wish for either or both honors, assignors or referees may make recommendations to a leagues regarding nominations, but only leagues may nominate.

To nominate a referee as **Oregon Referee of the year** – the USASA Referee of the Year application must be filled out and returned to the OASA office – it must be complete, including bio and photo of the referee. (Application below). Note: this is considered a “Lifetime Achievement Award”, for service to the adult game in Oregon and beyond, it is not an award for the “best” referee, or the referee doing the most in a given year.

The referee recognition committee will review nominations, and make recommendations to the OASA board; the OASA board will make the final selection of referee of the year and will nominate the selected referee for USASA Region IV Referee of the year.

To be eligible for selection to attend regional/national events a referee must:

1. Have refereed at least 10 affiliated adult games in the past year.
2. Met all requirements for their USSF grade.
3. Have agreed to be available for at least one of the listed regional and national events if selected.

To nominate a referee to **regional/national events** - Most of these events are best served by younger, up and coming referees, female referees are especially welcome. In order to be considered the referee must make themselves available for at least one of the following. Note these are dates of play; travel days will extend the time commitment. Referees at these events are often assessed by National assessors and are seen by national referee leaders, these are great opportunities for referees wishing to advance.

USASA Veteran’s Cup
USASA Coed Cup

The referee recognition committee will review nominations, and make recommendations to the OASA board, the OASA board will review them and make recommendations to the Oregon Referee Committee, the Oregon Referee Committee will make final determinations as to the appropriateness of sending a particular referee to a particular event, and will coordinate with chosen referees and the regional referee coordinator to ensure the correct fit between the referee and the event.

Referees who are selected for an event will receive coach airfare and lodging at the host hotel, other expenses will be the responsibility of the referee.
