Subject: Refund of Player Registration Fees

Effective Date: June 30 1992

The Executive Committee discussed some cases of players who had requested a refund of player fees for various reasons. It was decided that the basic policy will be that no refunds will be made for any reason.

Explanation:

There are many affiliated leagues and sanctioned events across the state, offering various formats of play throughout the calendar year. An OASA player card is required at all affiliated and sanctioned events. The OASA player card is the only proof of identification verifying a player's eligibility to participate. Additionally, registered players are covered by the USASA special accident insurance policy. Once an individual's player card has left the OASA office, there is no conclusive way to prove that player has NOT participated in an affiliated game; therefore, refunds cannot be issued.
